You are going to read a text about an unusual broadcasting experience which took place in America in the early 20th century. Read the text and answer the questions which follow. Choose only one answer for each question and circle the letter in front of it.

On the evening of 30th October 1938, millions of Americans were at home listening to the radio. On the radio station WABC, a play was announced: *The War of the Worlds*, directed by Orson Welles.

The programme started with dance music, but this was suddenly interrupted by a 'newsflash'. The newsreader reported that scientists had seen unusual lights on the planet Mars, nearing the planet Earth. After this, the music returned.

Then there was another newsflash. The audience heard that a spaceship had landed in New Jersey. Later reports said that more spaceships had landed and hundreds of people were dead. America was being attacked by creatures from Mars!

People forgot they were listening to a play. They thought the news was real. In New York, families hid or ran into the streets in panic. They were screaming and crying. The police received hundreds of phone calls and there were traffic jams as people tried to escape from the city.

The police contacted Orson Welles in the radio studio. At the end of the programme he announced that the news reports had been part of a play. But it was several hours before people calmed down and returned to their homes. Welles said later that he was amazed by people's response to the play and added: 'I don't think we'll choose anything like this again.'
