AT HOME WITH YOUR HOST FAMILY

You will have a single room with your host family unless you have asked specifically for a shared accommodation. Your room should be comfortable and have a bed, wardrobe, chest of drawers and a table or desk so that you are able to do your homework. There may be another student staying with the family at the same time, but there should be no other person of the same nationality or speaking the same first language in the accommodation.

We ask host families to show their student guests how to use the washing machine. Some host families include their guests' washing with the family's laundry. It is a good idea to check with your family how and when you can do your washing.

It is polite to let your host family know the approximate times you will be leaving the house and coming back. Try not to be late for meals and give plenty of notice if you intend to eat out. Your host family will give you breakfast and an evening meal every day and also lunch at the weekends. If you wish to go out for the day at the weekend, your host family will provide you with a packed lunch. If you are here for a long time, you may want to open an account. At the bank you will be asked to show your passport and your International Student card. You may need a letter from the school.

If you need to see a doctor or a dentist, ask your host family to make an appointment with their doctor or dentist. You do not always have to pay to see a doctor but you will have to pay for dental treatment.
